



GNE DEMOLITION DERBY RULES AND REGULATIONS

Powerwheels Class

Age Group: 4 – 10 years old (as of Sept 1st of the current year)

Time Limit: 10 – 15 minutes

General Rules:

1. All children **MUST** be signed in and have a waiver completed by their legal guardian
2. The child's legal guardian is responsible for the care and supervision of their child while in the special events area.
3. **ONE** Legal guardian is permitted in the special events area with the participant and **MUST BE RINGSIDE** for the duration of the event.
4. If the child becomes upset during the event and wants to get out of the vehicle, the track official will stop the derby so the caregiver can safely remove the child and their vehicle.
5. All children **MUST** wear approved safety helmets (ex; bicycle, hockey, atv, etc.)
6. All children **MUST** wear eye protection (ex; safety glasses)
7. Legal guardian and participant **MUST** wear appropriate footwear (specifically, closed toes work boots, bluntstones, or running shoes) in the special events area at all times. Flip flips or sandals are **NOT PERMITTED**.
8. Caregiver and child / participant are required to leave the special events area before the regular demolition derby begins. Vehicle holding the derby care are permitted to remain in the special events area.
9. **The health and safety of all participants, spectators, GNE personnel, and derby teams is everyone's responsibility.** Anybody who engages in aggressive behavior (either verbal or physical) towards committee members, fire and rescue personnel, or other participants will be immediately disqualified and escorted off the grounds. Security team members and / or OPP officers will be called as required to manage the situation.
10. The GNE and its officials will not be held responsible for any cars, parts or personal property before, during or after the event.

Officials will be using flag signals:

- **green** - start
- **red** - stop, there is an emergency, stop engine and remaining car
- **black** - you are disqualified, stop engine and remain in car
- **air horn** - fire, stop car and stop engine and remain in car unless told otherwise



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Entry Fee:

- There is no entry fee for the event, however participant and caregiver are required to pay general admissions at the Special Events Gate (Gate #10) upon entry
- ***Note; all entries need to bring completed registration form and entry fee in cash to the special events registration area by 10:30am on the day of the event.**

Power Wheel Build Rules:

1. All power wheels MUST remain stock with no added re-enforcements.
 - Additional weights of any kind are NOT PERMITTED
 - Modifications or updates to bumpers (ex; steel) are NOT PERMITTED
 - May change to or add rubber to wheels for gripping purpose only
 - ATV's or Tractors MUST have the legs protected if it is an open sided vehicle
2. May use factory 12 volt battery or change out to lawnmower, atv, or drill battery.
 - BATTERY MUST BE MOUNTED SECURELY AWAY FROM CHILD
3. Doors and hood MUST be zip tied shut.
4. Cars can be modified to resemble a derby car. All modifications must be made from plastic, PVC piping, cardboard or any material that is not going to cause injury. **Tube metal or wood is NOT PERMITTED.**
5. Recommend some type of seatbelt, especially for the smaller participants, to ensure they stay in their cars during the event.
6. All power wheels will be inspected before being allowed to run.
7. The GNE and its officials reserve the right to approve or reject any entries. **All decisions by the track official are final!**
